Six Building Permits were issued: one for a single family dwelling with 5 bedrooms and 3.5 baths located on Thunder Ridge Road, one for a single family dwelling with 4 bedrooms and 3 baths located on Douglas Road, one for a one room seasonal cabin located on Thistle Road, one to add a bedroom and bathroom to a dwelling located on Timberline Road, one for a storage shed located on Valley View Road, one to renovate decks on South Ridge Condo Buildings D and E and one for a detached garage on Branch Road.

Three Internal Plumbing Permits were issued and three septic permits were issued associated with the above Building Permits

Road Items:

Cross Excavation has completed: flushing a Roderick Road culvert; side slope armoring, gravel installation, ditch and culvert maintenance on the Sunday River Rd. gravel portion; improved drainage off Simmons Brook Bridge and cleaning/re-grouting /sealing the Branch Road Bridges. Road shoulder-ditch shaping on Skiway Road should start soon.

Road striping and curb painting plans are tentative for the 1^{st} or 2^{nd} week of August, to include new solid double yellow center stripes on the Sunday River Road from the Monkey Brook Intersection to the end of pavement.

The depression over a culvert on the Roderick Road has not shown signs of growing. If that trend continues, the plan is to have B. A. Manzer patch the spot, to include driveway gravel installation.

Doug Coombs, Maine DOT contacted me concerning the Sunday River Road guardrails and their attachment to the concrete bridge rails at both the State owned Sunday River Bridge and Town owned Simmons Brook Bridge. He said the State would drill the concrete bridge rails and attach the guardrails to the concrete bridge rails at both bridges if the Town would provide the work and materials needed to the guardrails at both Bridges to accommodate connection. The written work agreement MDOT is preparing hasn't arrived. I have contacted Superior Services, they should be providing a price estimate for the work and materials needed. Superior Services installed the guardrail originally
