New Business:

~**Discuss and consider signing the URIP form from Maine Local Roads:** We receive money from State for year prior road work. The amount was \$12,400.00. We need to tell State what money was used for. It was used for the Sunday River Road reconstruction. Selectman Conkright made motion to sign, Selectman Largess 2nd and voted all in favor to sign.

~**Discuss and consider casting a ballot for MMA Executive committee:** Board reviewed candidates. Selectman Largess made motion to vote for candidates as presented on Ballot, Selectman Conkright 2nd and voted all in favor.

~**Discuss and consider signing the Pine Tree contract for solid waste:** 3 year contract with Pine Tree Waste, Selectman Wight made motion to sign, Selectman Largess 2nd and voted all in favor. In addition, Dean Richmond presented a proposal to collect food waste at \$62 per ton. It would save \$30 a ton on MSW. Mr. Richmond works with business providing containers to dispose of food waste and collects it. Selectman Largess made motion to encourage Newry businesses to participate, Selectman Wight 2nd and voted all in favor.

~**Discuss and consider appointing Anita Clark to the Age Friendly Community Council:** Selectman Largess made motion to appoint Anita, Selectman Conkright 2nd, voted all in favor.

~**Discuss and consider signing off on the Tree Growth Abatement error for FY 2017-2018:** Due to a system glitch in TRIO, Tree Growth calculations were wrong at time of commitment. Assessing agent, Auditor and State Assessing Auditor all recommended abating the amounts. Selectman Largess made motion to approve TG abatements, Selectman Conkright 2nd, voted all in favor. ~**Discuss and consider signing declaration of Go Gold for Childhood Cancer Awareness:** This proclamation is to "Go Gold for Childhood Cancer Awareness" for the month of September. It was presented to office staff by a representative for "Haileys Hugs" Hailey Steward is a local girl battling cancer. 



Town Administrator's Reports: 8.1.17

- Harvest Hills, the Animal shelter the Town uses, sent their 2017-18 contract. The Town's ACO sign it; it reflects zero increases over last year's contract.
- The Planning Board has received legal review of the Sunday River Condo development application, there has been legal interaction between the Town's and Sunday River's lawyer. Correspondence has been sent to your emails.
- The State Legislature has a number of LD's they held over sent to various committee. The Marijuana Regulations are still being developed; we should expect to see some draft by October. The Local Option Sales Tax was defeated. However, the portion of the Marijuana sales tax is still a viable option for communities willing to allow sales
- MMA's Risk Management Act Plan from our May inspection is in, to be implemented.
- Mountain House application for site plan review application is on the Planning Board Agenda for tomorrow's meeting. The Planning Board requested additional information and it's expected a complete application will be submitted tomorrow by the Mountain House. A public hearing will be scheduled and notice given of the hearing soon.

Permits Issued:

Six Building Permits were issued: one for a single family dwelling with 5 bedrooms and 3.5 baths located on Thunder Ridge Road, one for a single family dwelling with 4 bedrooms and 3 baths located on Douglas Road, one for a one room seasonal cabin located on Thistle Road, one to add a bedroom and bathroom to a dwelling located on Timberline Road, one for a storage shed located on Valley View Road, one to renovate decks on South Ridge Condo Buildings D and E and one for a detached garage on Branch Road.

Three Internal Plumbing Permits were issued and three septic permits were issued associated with the above Building Permits

Road Items:

Cross Excavation has completed: flushing a Roderick Road culvert; side slope armoring, gravel installation, ditch and culvert maintenance on the Sunday River Rd. gravel portion; improved drainage off Simmons Brook Bridge and cleaning/re-grouting /sealing the Branch Road Bridges. Road shoulder-ditch shaping on Skiway Road should start soon.

Road striping and curb painting plans are tentative for the 1st or 2nd week of August, to include new solid double yellow center stripes on the Sunday River Road from the Monkey Brook Intersection to the end of pavement.

The depression over a culvert on the Roderick Road has not shown signs of growing. If that trend continues, the plan is to have B. A. Manzer patch the spot, to include driveway gravel installation.

Doug Coombs, Maine DOT contacted me concerning the Sunday River Road guardrails and their attachment to the concrete bridge rails at both the State owned Sunday River Bridge and Town owned Simmons Brook Bridge. He said the State would drill the concrete bridge rails and attach the guardrails to the concrete bridge rails at both bridges if the Town would provide the work and materials needed to the guardrails at both Bridges to accommodate connection. The written work agreement MDOT is preparing hasn't arrived. I have contacted Superior Services, they should be providing a price estimate for the work and materials needed. Superior Services installed the guardrail originally

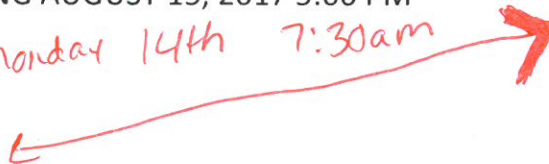

Selectman: Selectman Conkright says that powerline goes through proposed site for veteran's monument; need to coordinate with cemetery committee about moving lilac trees or other options.





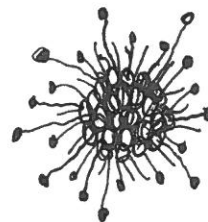
